



# Attempts to question FATF's credibility often reflect fear of scrutiny: India at UN

**UNITED NATIONS, JUNE 30:** India has said that attempts by countries to question the FATF's credibility reflect their fear of scrutiny and asked these nations to stop exporting instability and prevent their territory from being misused for terrorism, in a veiled reference to Pakistan. India's Permanent Representative to the UN, Parvathaneni Harish, made these remarks on Monday while addressing a 2026 Counter-Terrorism Week side event titled 'Joining Forces to Counter Terrorism Financing in the Context of Evolving Threats and Emerging Technologies'. "The FATF remains an indispensable pillar of the global counterterrorism financing and anti-money laundering architecture. Its work is technical, evidence-based and rooted in internationally accepted standards. Attempts to question its credibility often reflect fear of scrutiny rather than genuine process-related concerns," Harish said. The event was co-organised by the Permanent Missions of India and France to the United Nations, the

Counter-Terrorism Committee Executive Directorate (CTED), the United Nations Office of Counter-Terrorism (UNOCT), and the Global Internet Forum to Counter Terrorism (GIFCT). He said that countries facing adverse assessments should address the identified deficiencies, strengthen domestic enforcement, improve financial transparency, and demonstrate irreversible action against terror-financing networks. "The answer to FATF scrutiny is not politicised activism in UN forums but credible compliance. States that allow their territory, institutions or financial channels to be misused for terrorism must stop exporting instability and start fulfilling their obligations towards international peace and security," Harish said, making a thinly-veiled reference to Pakistan. Pakistan had been on the FATF grey list since 2018 but was removed in 2022. Harish told the event that he is not speaking on the issue of counter-terrorism in the abstract. "For decades now, my country, India, has confronted cross-border terrorism, and new digital technologies are

only making the sources, the methods, and channels used for the flow of assets more complex, he said. India has been a member of the influential global body that sets standards for combating money laundering and terrorist financing since 2010. Earlier this month, Union Culture Secretary Vivek Aggarwal was appointed Vice-President of the FATF for the July 2026-June 2027 period. Harish noted that in the current era of technological advancements, crowdfunding platforms and prepaid instruments have become central to the funding infrastructure of global terrorist operations. "Crowdfunding from radicalised individuals for terrorist financing and use of tokens, stars and points in social media platforms by terrorists to store and transfer their value are real issues of deep concern for all of us, he said. Terrorists are technology neutral, and they adopt whatever is cheap, fast, lightly-regulated, and whatever works for them, he said. "Our response must be a risk-based architecture anchored in the FATF standards, Harish said, adding that history shows

that critical terrorist financing risks have not emerged anonymously. "They have been sponsored, including by some state actors, again, a reference to Pakistan. Harish said regulation must not punish the legitimate. "Steps towards financial inclusion, humanitarian action and responsible innovation are only undermined when illicit flows go unchecked. Therefore, the regulatory outcome should be proportional, not prohibitive," he said. India has made an "honest effort" to practice what it advocates. We have brought virtual asset service providers within our anti-money laundering framework. We have tightened verification requirements for centralised exchanges and users, and we have contributed case studies to the FATF's updates and best practices to mitigate terror financing risks, he said. In October 2022, the Security Council Counter-Terrorism Committee (CTC), chaired by India that year, had organised a Special Meeting in New Delhi and Mumbai on the overarching theme of 'Countering the use of new

and emerging technologies for terrorist purposes'. As an outcome of the special meeting, the Committee had adopted the Delhi Declaration' on countering the use of new and emerging technologies for terrorist purposes. Harish said India had chosen to focus the committee's attention on two frontiers: virtual assets and online platforms, adding that as head of UNSC CTC, India had developed the non-binding guiding principles pursuant to the Delhi Declaration. "It is a matter of great satisfaction that its pillars are being taken forward and the world is gaining from it," he said. In his remarks to the Fourth High-Level Conference on Counter-Terrorism, UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres said that the world is grappling with acute instability as conflicts are triggering energy shocks, inflation and hunger across the globe, millions are displaced, and millions more are facing economic hardship. "These conditions of want, of fragility, of mistrust are ideal circumstances for terror to thrive. From Africa to South Asia, and across the Middle East, affiliates of Al-Qaida and

Da'esh and other terrorist groups persist," he said. Guterres said violent extremist narratives including those based on xenophobia, racism, and other forms of intolerance, or in the name of religion or belief pose deadly domestic threats in many nations. Terrorists of all stripes are adapting. New technologies make it easier for them to finance and recruit. Criminal networks speed the flow of cash and weapons, now including deadly drones, he added. Terrorists have grown adept at exploiting emerging technologies, including artificial intelligence, digital platforms, and unmanned weapons, he said. While these tools have supercharged their ability to recruit, finance and plan attacks, technology also offers powerful tools to detect threats early, stop the flow of illicit assets, and understand pathways to terrorist radicalisation, he said. Guterres called on the international community to cooperate to address the conditions and grievances that allow terrorism to take root and stressed that terrorism is a transnational threat, and no nation can address it alone.

### 14 prisoners escape while being taken to jail in Pak's Punjab

**ISLAMABAD:** At least 14 undertrial prisoners escaped while being taken to Adiala Jail in Pakistan's Punjab province, a media report said on Tuesday. Police managed to capture four of the prisoners, while search operations are underway to trace the remaining 10, the Express Tribune reported. The incident occurred on Monday when 36 undertrial prisoners were being escorted to jail after their court appearance at Kahuta tehsil court near Rawalpindi. When the prison van reached Chakian area within the jurisdiction of Sihala Police Station in Islamabad, the escort personnel heard shouting and fighting from inside the prisoners' compartment in the vehicle. According to police, Sub-Inspector Imtiaz, who was leading the team, opened the prisoners' compartment to intervene. At that moment, some of the inmates allegedly threw red chilli powder into the eyes of the police personnel before fleeing in different directions, police said. Four of the fleeing prisoners were immediately overpowered and taken back into custody, while 10 others managed to escape, the report said.

### Venezuela appreciates Indian team's efforts to help earthquake victim

**CARACAS:** Venezuela has appreciated the Indian medical team's efforts to help victims of the earthquake that rocked the South American nation, killing over 1,700 people. Under Operation Amistad, the Indian Army established a field hospital comprising highly experienced doctors at the International La Rinconada Racetrack in Caracas after arriving in the country. The Indian Embassy in Venezuela on Monday said that India has intensified its efforts to provide disaster relief with a healing touch to those affected by the earthquake. Minister of People's Power for Foreign Minister, Andrea Corao Faria, visited our Field Hospital and appreciated our efforts to help the earthquake victims, the Indian mission said. The 7.2 and 7.5-magnitude earthquakes that struck on Wednesday evening were among the strongest in Venezuela in more than a century and were felt throughout the region. The death toll from two powerful quakes in Venezuela crossed 1,700 people on Monday, with thousands more injured and many more missing.

## Don't care about name on letterhead: Sergio Gor on Indo-Pacific command row

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**WASHINGTON, JUNE 30:** US Ambassador to India Sergio Gor dismissed the row over the renaming of the Indo-Pacific Command, saying the "name on the letterhead" does not matter rather look at what America is actually doing. Addressing the US-India Strategic Partnership Forum Leadership Summit on Monday, Gor said India still conducts more military exercises with the US than any other country and has regular bilateral visits of defence officials. Gor's remarks came in the wake of a row over dropping Indo' from the Indo-Pacific Command. Established in 1947, the US Pacific Command is among the oldest unified commands of the US that extends from the west coast of the US to India's western border. During US President Donald Trump's first term, the Pacific Command was renamed as Indo-Pacific Command, citing the growing importance of India in the Indo-Pacific region.

Earlier, this month the US restored the original name of the unified command. "I just want to mention something because a lot of individuals made hay

over a name change. I don't care what name is on a letterhead, but look at what the United States is actually doing," Gor said. "Yes, the name changed; we're still there. India still has more exercises with the United States than any other country by far. Every single month there's something happening, whether it's Indian troops coming here or whether it's US troops going into the region," the US envoy said. He said in the next two weeks, a delegation of the Indian Navy will be visiting the US. Gor also rejected suggestions that bilateral ties had weakened, Gor said the overall relationship remained on a strong footing. "So to all those pundits that sit online and tweet and say, this relationship is in trouble, when you look at the facts of where this relationship stands, whether it's trade, whether it's defence, whether it's the people to people ties, the

relationship is on strong footing," he said. Gor said President Trump attached significant importance to ties with India and remained committed to expanding cooperation across trade, technology, defence and investment. The US envoy to India recalled an incident when Trump decided to call Modi from Miami, where he was attending the Ultimate Fighting Championship bouts. "It was a couple months ago... with the president at UFC in Miami and we're sitting backstage and he said to me, 'Let's call the Prime Minister'," Gor said. "I said, 'Sir, it's 6:00 AM in the morning there (India).'" He said, 'He (Modi) will be up. He (Modi) is like me,'"

Gor said, recalling Trump's remarks. Gor said by the time he managed to speak to a few people in New Delhi, Trump was already on the UFC stage and eventually the call with Modi was scheduled for the following day.

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**WASHINGTON, JUNE 30:** Emerging technologies would define the next phase of India-US cooperation, India's Ambassador to the US Vinay Mohan Kwatra said here, listing out biotechnology, artificial intelligence and semiconductors as priority sectors. Addressing the USISPF Leadership Summit here, Kwatra said India has positioned itself as a preferred destination for companies seeking to diversify production and supply chains beyond traditional manufacturing hubs. He said India has stepped up investments in strategic sectors including semiconductors, electronics, artificial intelligence, clean energy and defence manufacturing, strengthening its role in
