

Post Office burglarised, cash and valuables stolen

Udaipur: Aug 27. Thieves broke into the Udaipur Khilpara Post Office and allegedly stole several lakh rupees in cash and other valuables items. The theft was discovered this morning when employee Nani Gopal Das arrived to open the post office.

Das found the office in disarray and the door broken. He immediately informed officials at the Udaipur Jamtala post office.

Officials later visited the post office and conducted a preliminary assessment, confirming the theft of cash and other items.

A written complaint was lodged at Radhakishorepur police station. Police reached the spot and launched an investigation into the incident. Police are investigating how the thieves entered the post office and identifying those involved. Efforts are underway to recover the stolen cash and belongings and arrest the accused.

GMLTEA submits five-point demands to Health Director

Agartala/Udaipur: Aug 27. The Government/General Medical Laboratory Technologists Employees Association (GMLTEA) today submitted a five-point charter of demands to the Director of Health Services, seeking changes in designation, promotion, pay benefits, adequate manpower and a structured career progression system for Medical Laboratory Technology professionals.

The association demanded that “Laboratory Technician” and “Laboratory Technician (Blood)” be redesignated as “Medical Laboratory Technologist” and “Medical Laboratory Technologist (Blood)”, respectively.

It sought priority promotion for employees who have completed 10 years or more of service and demanded a career structure providing at least three regular promotions during their service.

GMLTEA also demanded professional parity and dignity with nursing professionals, an appropriate Pay Level/Pay Scale, Dress Grant and Risk/Hazardous Duty Allowance considering the nature of laboratory work.

The association called for adequate recruitment of Laboratory Technicians/Medical Laboratory Technologists at PHCs, CHCs, Sub-Divisional Hospitals and District Hospitals to ensure 24-hour laboratory services. It also demanded the introduction of a proper shift-duty system after sufficient manpower is ensured to prevent excessive workload.

The Director of Health Services informed the delegation that he was aware of the issues related to designation changes and career progression and said the matters were under official processing.

GMLTEA urged the Health Department to take early action on its five-point charter, stating that the demands concern the professional rights and working conditions of Medical Laboratory Technology personnel and uninterrupted healthcare services.

Two new water treatment plants planned for Agartala 64.78% households have coverage: CM

Agartala: Aug 27. The Tripura government has finalised plans for two new water treatment plants in Agartala, with work orders already issued, Chief Minister Prof Dr Manik Saha informed the Assembly on Thursday. The announcement came in response to queries from Congress MLAs Gopal Chandra Roy and Sudip Roy Barman over drinking water shortages and quality in the Agartala Municipal Corporation (AMC) area.

According to Saha, a 550-lakh-litre-per-day groundwater treatment plant will be constructed at Netaji Adarsha Shiksha Mandir, while a 641-lakh-litre-per-day surface water treatment plant will come up at College Tilla. The groundwater plant is scheduled for completion by July 2027 and the College Tilla project by January 2028.

Replying to the legislators, the Chief Minister said Agartala has 1,44,752 households, of which around 92,590

have been provided water coverage, accounting for 64.78%. The government, he said, is working towards achieving 100% coverage. The city requires approximately 100 million litres of water daily, while households without direct connections depend on roadside hydrants and private tube wells.

MLA Roy questioned the government over the continuing shortage and alleged that many residents were not receiving adequate supplies of treated drinking water. He also expressed doubts over whether the proposed projects would be completed within the announced timelines.

Saha said the city currently receives around 25% of its water from the Haora River, with the remaining 75% sourced from groundwater. He maintained that groundwater extraction was currently at 61.3%, below the 70% limit prescribed by the Central Ground Water Board.

He further said that Agartala currently has 13 surface wa-

ter treatment plants, 36 modified iron removal plants, six package-type iron removal plants and 77 deep tube wells supplying drinking water. Water quality is tested daily in treatment plant laboratories, while trained Self-Help Group members also conduct household-level testing using Field Test Kits.

Saha said projects supported by the Asian Development Bank include two surface water treatment plants, 17 modified iron removal plants and several deep tube wells. The government also plans to check dams, pick-up weirs and mini-barrages on the Haora River to increase reliance on surface water.

Responding to concerns over contamination, Sudip Roy Barman sought clarification on treatment methods for surface and groundwater sources. Saha said the government was monitoring the issue and assured the House that efforts were underway to address Agartala's drinking water crisis.

Modern ITI Training Centre set to open new horizons in Technical Education

Kailashahar: Aug 27. A modern Industrial Training Institute (ITI) training centre is taking shape in Kailashahar as part of a major initiative to upgrade technical education and skill development infrastructure across Tripura. The project, being implemented jointly by Tata Consultancy Services (TCS) and the state government, is expected to provide local youths with industry-oriented training and improve their employment prospects. The Kailashahar centre is being developed at an estimated cost of around 76 crore, with construction now nearing completion. Bidhan Das, Technical Advisor overseeing the project, said on Tuesday that nearly 100 per cent of the construction work has been completed. The initiative covers the modernisation of 19 ITI training centres across the state. According to officials, the upgraded institutions will be transformed into skill development hubs equipped with modern technology, industry-relevant courses and trained instructors. The training programmes are being designed in accordance with the changing requirements of the industrial sector and the emerging demands of Industry 4.0. Plans include the introduction of eight long-term and 23 short-term courses across the upgraded ITIs and skill development centres. Once fully operational, the network is expected to have the capacity to train more than 9,000 students annually through long-term courses, while over 1 lakh students could receive training through short-term programmes. The Kailashahar centre, equipped with modern infrastructure and technology-based facilities, is expected to significantly expand access to quality technical education in Unakoti district. Industry-linked training is also likely to enhance the employability of trainees by equipping them with skills relevant to the present job market. The establishment of the centre has been welcomed by local residents, who believe it will create new opportunities for unemployed and aspiring youths in the district. With technical education gaining increasing importance alongside conventional higher education, the upgraded ITI is expected to emerge as an important institution for developing skilled manpower and supporting employment generation in Unakoti.

Rupaichari block launches digital platform for public services

Sabroom: Aug 27. Rupaichari RD Block has launched a dedicated website to bring multiple government services closer to residents, enabling them to submit complaints, apply for selected services and order products online from home.

The initiative aims to reduce the gap between the administration and the public by bringing several citizen-centric services under a single digital platform. Block Development Officer Pritam Debnath said the initiative was launched in line with the Government of India's Digital India vision.

One of the key features is “Click for Cleanliness,” which allows residents to upload photographs and locations of areas where plastic or garbage has accumulated. The information will reach the administration, enabling necessary cleanliness measures to be taken.

The website also integrates the “E-Panch Connect” service, which was previously available through a QR-code-based system. Residents can now apply online for selected services and receive the required certificates digitally.

Initially, Rupaichhari Panchayat Village Committee has been selected as a pilot project among the block's 18 Village Committees.

The platform also enables online ordering of products from various TLM units, food supplements and other items. Residents can additionally submit feedback and opinions through the website.

Debnath urged residents to use the digital platform to access government services more conveniently.

India's economy remains resilient amid global headwinds: RBI bulletin

New Delhi: Aug 27. India's economy, driven by buoyant domestic demand and rising manufacturing and services activity, has demonstrated notable resilience to the ongoing global headwinds, according to the RBI's monthly bulletin released on Tuesday.

The global economic outlook continues to be shaped by geopolitical frictions in West Asia and fresh tariffs by the US. Despite these risks to global trade and the growth-inflation matrix, India's robust macroeconomic fundamentals continue to provide a cushion to the domestic economy, the bulletin stated.

The momentum of Q1:2026-27 continued in July with domestic demand remaining buoyant, as reflected by several indicators, including vehicle and tractor sales. Petroleum product consumption growth returned to positive territory, after three straight months of contrac-

tion. Industrial production strengthened sharply in June, recording its strongest growth in nearly two years, supported by a broad-based acceleration in manufacturing. The services sector also exhibited resilience, the RBI bulletin observed.

The recovery in southwest monsoon in July helped kharif sowing reach closer to normal acreage, partly mitigating some of the risks to the agriculture sector. Backed by a high stock of public foodgrains, the government has also announced an Open Market Sales Scheme for the current financial year to augment supply.

While headline CPI inflation edged up above the target, it was primarily on account of supply-side pressures, the bulletin said, noting that stable core inflation reaffirmed the lower pass-through of cost pressures.

Financial conditions are characterised by high credit growth, comfortable liquidity, and softening G-sec yields supported by a rebound in capital inflows. Liquidity con-

ditions eased, supporting credit growth and ongoing investment activity, it said.

The bulletin also highlights that foreign capital inflows rebounded during the month, reinforcing the external sector. Both merchandise exports and imports grew strongly in July 2026, with exports growing at a four-month high in 2026-27 so far. The merchandise trade deficit widened in July, both sequentially and on a year-on-year (y-o-y) basis, reflecting a widening of the deficit in electronic goods.

The Centre's fiscal deficit increased marginally during Q1:2026-27 as compared to the previous year, accompanied by higher capital expenditure. The gross fiscal deficit of the states has been lower during the same period. System liquidity improved in July and August. The liquidity surplus narrowed in the second half of July on account of tax outflows, but it went up in August on account of draw-down of the government cash balances and measures taken to attract capital, the bulletin stated.
